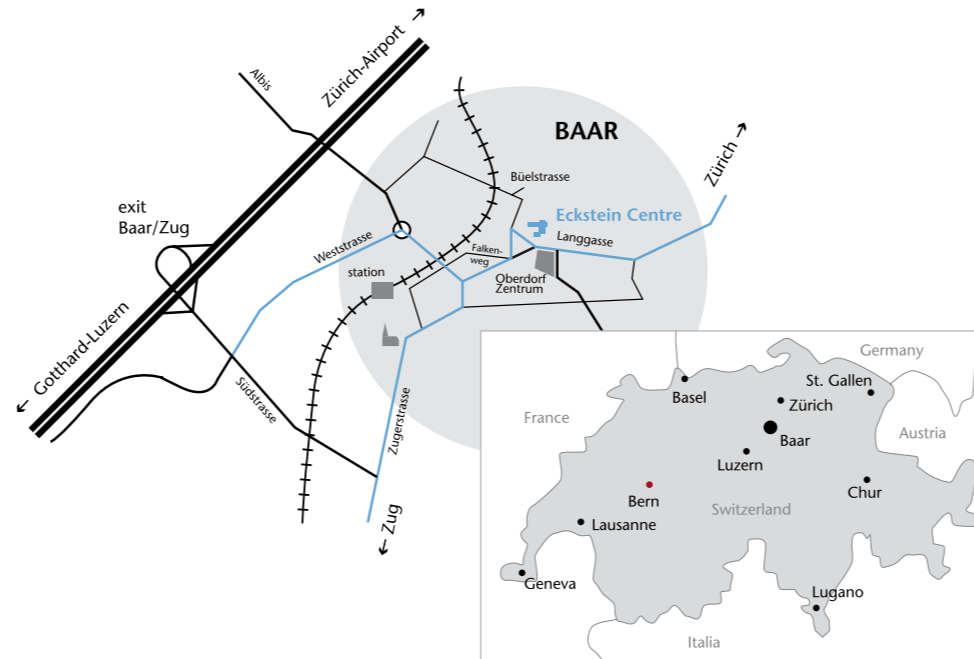

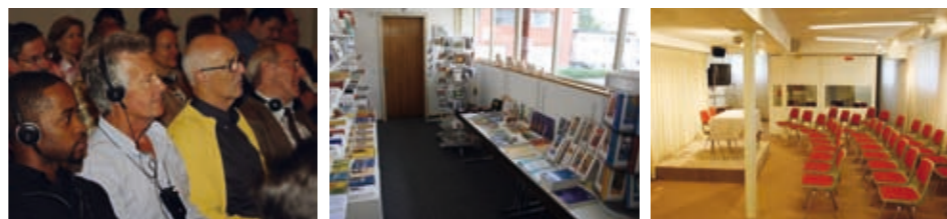
### Who we are

The Eckstein Centre is a training establishment of the Focolare Movement, a non-profit association. Initiated during the Second World War in Italy, the Focolare Movement is part of the springtime of new charisms in modern christianity, recognised by the Catholic and most major Churches. It offers a spirituality of unity bringing about a dialogue of life. Central principals are ecumenism as well as working together with people of other religions and of no formal faith. Chiara Lubich, founder of the Focolare Movement, received many prizes for the Movement’s work throughout the world, including the UNESCO peace prize in 1996 and the European Council human rights prize in 1998.

The invitingly arranged house, with its Cafeteria, courtyard, and various cosy corners, provides many opportunities to sit together and converse informally. The ecumenical chapel is available for worship, prayer and recollection.
